NEW CERTIFICATE FOR INTRO LESSON

As an additional encouragement for new WBS students to continue their study of the Master Series, we now offer a new certificate for students who complete the Master Series Introduction course (“the Intro”). The online certificate (left) will be

available soon for online study helpers to award to their online students by “checking the box” after completion of the Intro, just like they do now to award certificates for all the other Master Series courses. For postal students, the Introduction certificate (right) is available now by ordering from WBS just like the other certificates you already use. We ask all online and postal study helpers to award this new certificate to every student who completes the Intro to encourage them to continue deeper into the Master Series.



SCANNING SPEEDS STUDENT RETURNS

We continue to look for ways to use technology to improve the WBS postal teaching process. Several years ago, we began to offer scanning as a way to speed student returns from Zimbabwe, reducing the return time from weeks or months to just days. For churches that receive Zimbabwe student returns via scanning, it works like this: **1.** Rather than bulk mailing returns to the Cedar Park office, where we sort and then mail the returns to the appropriate congregation, the Zimbabwe postal service center uploads each student return sheet to a website. **2.** We then notify each congregation that their return sheets are ready to download. **3.** They download and print the return sheets, and give them to their study helpers for grading. **4.** They then mail the graded return sheet and next lessons back to their students. The time and dollar savings achieved by eliminating the mailing component is quite large! Today we offer this same opportunity in 11 African countries. GHANA PREP 2.0—STUDY HELPERS NEEDED NOW!

After a two-year pilot program and many lessons learned, Ghana P.R.E.P. (Partners in Religious Education Project) is moving forward with a new strategy. While our original plan of being officially sanctioned for use in Ghanaian public high schools did not work out, we are now offering WBS in an “extra-curricular” capacity in Ghanaian high schools. The doors are open and the opportunities are great. In fact, as I write this we have over 1,700 students waiting for study helpers to adopt them.

The new “extra-curricular” strategy works like this:

- Students work at their own pace, not on a strict time schedule as before.
- Lessons are distributed to students one lesson at a time, by a school-based coordinator who is a member of the church of Christ.
- Churches are billed only for each lesson used, not an upfront amount for each student registered.

With this strategy in place we are seeing early indications of very positive results:

- Rapid lesson turnaround to and from Ghana (using two-way scanning)
- Higher retention rates through the entire Master Series (up to 74% in some cases)
- Significant cost reduction (\$7 total cost for a student who goes through the entire Master Series vs. the higher cost of purchasing and mailing booklets before PREP)

ADVERTISE WBS THROUGH YOUR BUSINESS

Recently we received an inquiry from a WBS Coordinator in Tennessee. He said that a member at his congregation wanted to use his personal business to advertise WBS to potential students. Since he ships products to locations all around the U.S. and to foreign countries, he decided to place a WBS business card into each box, inviting the reader to register to study with WBS. We were happy to work out the details, and now this plan is in action sending personalized business cards to those who receive shipments. (So far 5,000 cards have been sent!) This idea can easily be repeated in other locations. Students who register can be placed on the worldwide student board for adoption by any WBS study helper, or they can be sent directly to your congregation to be taught by your own members. We really appreciate this proactive effort to recruit WBS students, and hope that others will want to try the same approach. Contact us for details.

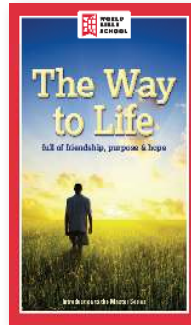

Introductory Course: THE WAY TO LIFE



Thank you for your partnership in the Gospel with WBS! With these grading keys we also present some helpful notes about handling student responses. We pray your ministry to the lost is eternally fruitful.

1 After you have your student names, mail *The Way to Life* to each of them. See Section 2 of the *Postal Program Guide* for detailed instructions. Download it at worldbibleschool.net/resources

2 Now be patient and prayerful! It takes time for lessons to get to the students. Postal systems in some countries have problems, so correspondence may be slow. It may even get lost. Some students may need time to delve into their studies. If you do not hear from one of your students within two or three months, write them a letter and ask if they received the lesson. Let them know you care and that you want to encourage them.

3 Continue on a weekly basis to send *The Way* to new students. (Remember the parable of the seed and soil.) This will eventually build the pipeline of students who will actually continue to study.

4 Responsive students who have the means will return their answers to you. Grade only the Choice Questions, using the appropriate grading key. Congratulate good efforts. Comment on Choice Questions answered incorrectly. Learn about your student from his answers to the Discussion Questions—but don't grade them and don't feel you must correct every misconception. Be positive and encourage the student's further openness. Try to answer the student's questions. Keep your answers simple and use Bible references. If the student asks too many questions, try to answer the most important ones. If questions are too difficult, get help from fellow church members.

5 Note the religion of the student. If they are Muslim, send them *The Prophets of God* instead of *God Has Spoken*, then *Jesus the Messiah* instead of *Knowing Jesus*. Note the age of the student the student. If they are 12 or under, send them *Becoming Friends*, the first of the three children's courses, then the other children's courses thereafter.

6 On Return Page 4 the student gives you personal contact and background information. Keep this as it will prove important later for follow up. Section 2 of the *Postal Program Guide* tells you more about keeping such records.

7 Keep praying! The Lord cares the most about your students.



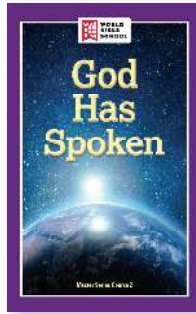

GOD HAS SPOKEN Many believe in God, but in this course Scripture shapes the student's world-view. Like Paul's teaching, this course aims at faith and repentance (Acts 17:22-31; 20:21; 26:20). Hebrews 6:1 calls "faith in God" and "repentance" part of the foundation on which we must build. The student can prepare to be more serious in seeking God's way.

THIS IS GOOD NEWS As the "invitation" of the Master Series, this course seeks heartfelt obedience to the Gospel. It calls for response appropriate to each student's readiness. Motivation is at 3 levels: 1) Seekers will seriously investigate the credentials of the Gospel. 2) Believers will overcome objections and obey. 3) Obedient believers will share the Gospel with others.

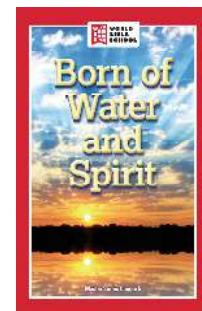
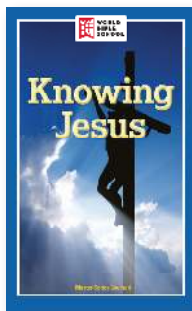

KNOWING JESUS Many millions have never heard the name of Jesus. Millions of others claim to be “Christians”, but hold a variety of non-biblical views. Many of them have little Bible knowledge even though the message of original Christianity was Jesus—the real Jesus. Scripture builds accurate knowledge of, and firm faith in, Jesus as our Lord and Savior. The goal of this course is to build that abiding relationship, which Scripture calls knowing Jesus.

BORN OF WATER AND SPIRIT The Great Commission says “make disciples”, not just “send information”. Early evangelists added persuasion to their delivery of Gospel facts. In the same spirit, this course “reasons from the Scriptures”, “explains” and “persuades” (Acts 2:40; 17:2-4; 18:4). It approaches the subject of salvation through Jesus’ discussion with Nicodemus. Jesus clearly require the second birth. It results in the responsive student’s new life.
