Earlier Access to Students

Web students are now being placed on the Student Board as soon as they register. Prior to this change, Web students had to complete the Introductory lesson first. Now, teachers can send newly registered

students encouragement notes or even adopt the student before the first lesson is completed. Our hope is that an encouraging body of WBS study helpers will motivate more students to complete more Bible lessons.

Connect Is Now Free

Connect is now available at no cost for a one year experiment. Congregations or individuals who want to reach seekers in their hometown or a mission field can now get started with no upfront financial investment.

A Personal URL for Finding Students

To make free Connect more accessible to every WBS study helper, each one can get a personal Connect Web address with a single click. With it, a study helper can have a Web address to share on Facebook, place in an email signature or print on a business card. When a seeker enrolls for Bible study via that link, that seeker will study with

"To the End of the Earth"

hen the first disciples heard their commission, "Go into all the world," they must have been overwhelmed. Today the world's population is 24 times larger than then. Yet the commission is more attainable because of the reach and speed of technology, especially interactive Bible studies via Internet. World Bible School has set the gold standard for correspondence Bible study for decades. Now WBS and World English Institute (WEI) have remarkable teaching web sites and active students in *every* country of the world.

Take Mongolia as an example. In the last eight years, WEI has registered over 10,000 students for Bible study in that nation where churches of Christ seemed non-existent. This April, WEI hosted a

large reception for their students in Mongolia's capital, Ulaanbaatar. After the reception our team of six Christians studied with many of these



students for two weeks. There are now 15 baptized believers in Ulaanbaatar. These students had been studying the Bible for months and years on the WEI web site. They were ready to make a decision. They have become the Lord's church there.

These baby Christians will be nurtured and taught through Skype technology and a missionary in China who has committed to going there frequently and helping guide the young church. Thanks to Internet correspondence ministries like WBS and WEI, "Go into all the world..." is not so overwhelming after all. Praise God for these ministries and modern tools of communication!

arl Mitchell (89) recently retired from the Board of World Bible School. His many years of Kingdom experience brought a treasure of wisdom to guide WBS. He and Frankie encouraged me in my role as WBS president, and re-emphasized the grand spiritual and pro-

president, and re-emphasized the grand spiritual and promotional principles on which their friend Jimmie Lovell had launched WBS.

Carl and Frankie's list of accomplishments is long and profound. After 18 years in Italy, their contact and influence there has been continuous. Carl was a professor of Psychology and Theology at Pepperdine for 20 years, then a professor of Theology, Missiology and Christian Counseling at Harding University for 23 years. He also served as Dean at both universities.

Harding's president Dr. Bruce McLarty sums up Carl's influence this way:

Dr. Carl Mitchell, an icon at Harding University where he served as the Dean of the College of Bible for seven years, was the creative force behind Harding's Marriage and Family Therapy program and has long served as a wise and trusted counselor to Harding presidents. Dr. Mitchell is a man of many talents and interests.... Everyone who knows the Mitchells is keenly aware of their deep affection for their adopted homeland [Italy].

The Mitchells bless WBS similarly. They currently live in Mesquite, Texas.

Sunset & WBS Tech Partnership

Institute (Sunset) has long been developing the content for the solar-powered audio player technology now available. The solar player effectively places the encyclopedic course lectures of Sunset into the hands of thousands of

church members and leaders in targeted areas of Africa. WBS partners with Sunset by providing the evangelistic component of the player's content. The Phase One release of the player



included the WBS Master Series voiced by Charles Ellis of the Oldham Lane church in Abilene, Texas. The Phase Two release in March added WBS' "Guide to New Testament Christianity." With WBS's evangelistic lead-in for listeners, and the rich biblical study in Sunset's course lectures, many people have

the opportunity to learn of God and delve deeply into His Word. We commend Sunset and praise God for the innovative ways available to share Jesus.



This is one-way scanning, where WBS gets Return Sheets to you faster, and only in Zimbabwe—for now.

Lord willing, we launch another pilot project in Ghana this fall. What will be different? PREP (Partners in Religious Education Project) uses WBS courses alongside other curricula in public schools. Since we must function within the school term time-frame, we must be able to time the correspondence between students and Study Helpers. Enter two—way scanning. If churches were able to scan and upload their responses to students, then "postal WBS" would enter a whole new world.

We approximate that the turnaround time for exchanges between students and teacher to be about two weeks. To anyone with much experience in traditional WBS postal correspondence study, this is a stratospheric leap forward.

And if this project works as we expect to in Ghana, WBS will look to the rest of the world. We are, after all, *World* Bible School, and as technology makes the world smaller, the progress of the Great Commission becomes greater.

Connect Caribbean

The Beltline church of Christ in Decatur, Alabama, uses WBS Connect and WBS Web Ads to reach seekers in the Caribbean. WBS Web Ads are a way for congregations to advertise Bible study on the Internet. Over 1,000 people have signed up to study the Bible through this effort.

Connect Personal

Kami, at the Westside church of Christ in Round Rock, Texas, set up a WBS Connect personal campaign. She shared her campaign link on Facebook. Three of her friends quickly joined her for Bible study.

Connect College Station
Billie Jean decided to use WBS
Web Ads to promote Bible study in
her hometown of College Station,
Texas. Only a few hours later, the
first student registered to study via
postal mail.

WBS teachers are placing WBS Connect web addresses on business cards, flyers, websites, Facebook, TV shows, radio shows and everywhere in between. In the first three months of 2015, over 3,500 students registered through Connect. These are students in targeted areas. Many are already in contact with the local church, but simply needed that extra step to begin study in God's Word.

High Tech and Postal:

A Winning Combination

he Hillcrest church in Abilene, Texas, has had a postal WBS program for 32 years. Recently the congregation began to expand into Web teaching through their Connect program of local evangelism. A number of their new contacts made through the Web have requested postal studies. In fact, among Connect programs targeting the U.S., about one out of three WBS enrolees choose to study postal lessons. Furthermore, the postal team is exploring new ways for technology to reduce the turn-around time for lesson returns.

In a recent recruitment and training meeting, many of the younger generation were attracted to the Web-based study tools of WBS. At the same time, many others were attracted to the team work dynamic of the postal team. Most importantly, both groups grew in appreciation for one another and learned how, together, evangelism is more effective!

The majority of the world can still study Bible correspondence by mail, but an ever increasing number of people are gaining access to the Web. Going into all the world includes a faithful proclamation of the Gospel in both arenas. WBS seeks to provide excellent tools to make postal programs and high-tech programs a winning combination!

Scanning for Speed

These are the challenges that accompany any system of correspondence, and World Bible School wrestles with them mightily. With more Study Helpers using digital communications, and most students still using pen and paper,

we have an opportunity to see what current technology can do for the Great Commission.

Three years ago WBS began experiments using scanning to enhance speed, efficiency and savings. We set up a high-speed scanner and computer at our Service Center in Zimbabwe and recruited churches willing to try a new experience. Our Zimbabwe staff receives Return Sheets, scans them, and uploads to Internet file sharing for the participating churches. WBS teaching teams then download and print the Return Sheets and grade them just as they always have, but they are getting them weeks, even months faster! And on average, they save about 15 cents per student, per exchange.

id you see the April 3, 2015, USA Today headline: "Islamic faith is faster-growing"? The Pew Research Center projects that "Muslims will outnumber Christians by 2070, ending two millenniums of Christian domination." It's hard to imagine Pew or its equivalent keeping track that far back. But that doesn't lessen their point that "Islam is projected

to grow more than twice as fast as any other major religion over the next half-century because of a

higher fertility rate." So, should New Testament Christians just accept Islamic domination as another inevitable trend?

How often are you hearing broadcasts that report, "ISIS uses social media to recruit terrorists"? They reach millions

with their message and even recruit thousands of Westerners. So, should New Testament Christians just acquiesce? Do we passively hand over the Internet to those who recruit, radicalize and intimidate with ghastly executions?

Have you noticed? While we wonder how to reach young people, the opposition clearly believes in the Internet's power to target and influence youth. Their recruits tend to be between 18-29 years old. Further, they put their money where their faith is. They invest millions in social media. Matt Olsen, former director



of National Counterterrorism says, "Groups like ISIS have a very sophisticated propaganda machine, in fact the most sophisticated propaganda we've seen from any terrorist organization." So, is our passion for good greater than theirs for evil? Do we as New Testament Christians put our money where our faith is?

Some say that World War III has started. Regardless, we all are engulfed in a far greater war already. It began this side of Eden. It surged to fiercer intensity on earth when heaven cast out our enemy, the Dragon (Revelation 12; Ephesians 6). If we as New Testament Christians are to take the offensive, this is the time!
