Another Seeker **Connected** to Christ

On August 3, Jose Rosado was baptized into Christ by Timothy (Tim) Gean, preacher at the Shiawassee church of Christ in Owosso, Michigan (a congregation with an average Sunday attendance of 16). The baptism took place at the Waterford, Michigan church of Christ, about 20 minutes from Jose's home in Pontiac.

Jose learned about WBS on the internet, and registered as an Online Student. At the same time, the Shiawassee congregation had set up a WBS Connect Web Target that extended 75 miles from Owosso in each direction. After Jose registered, the four members at Shiawassee who are Study Helpers received an email notifying them of the new Student inside their Web Target. Tim adopted Jose and began studying with him online.

Jose quickly completed the lessons. He said he was fed up with the path he had taken into sin, ashamed of things he had done. Fortunately for him, WBS showed him the way out. Jose is now our brother in the Lord, and attends the Waterford church of Christ.

Jose is a perfect example of a seeker hearing and responding to the Gospel message presented in WBS lessons, shared by a dedicated Study Helper. Tim Gean and the members at the Shiawassee church of Christ are proof WBS outreach tools can help any congregation, large or small, share the Gospel where they live and beyond.

As for Tim, he is sold on WBS. Tim said, "Through the World Bible School, this man inhaled the lessons, sometimes doing 2-3 per week. I learned to love Jose, his heart, attitude and hunger for the word of God. Now he is our brother in Christ. It made my year."

Upon my first visit, Tim was only interested and "thinking about" teaching with WBS. After reaching out to me again later this year, I hosted multiple seminars and tutorials with their congregation on Sunday evenings over Zoom. During this process, we set up a Web Target in May, which is what ultimately led them to Jose.

Zambia Prison Ministries

Over three decades ago, Ruth Orr with Church Street in Lewisburg, TN studied with WBS students in Zambia Africa. Today those same students who obeyed the Gospel have shared the Good News with thousands in their country of Zambia. Thomas Sakala, Rodgers Chuulu, and Melvin Kalinmanshila share lessons in 11 different prisons from Livingston in the South, North to Chingola in the Copperbelt and East to Serenje.

Teachers with Concord Road church of Christ in Brentwood, Tennessee partner and support these brothers in the work. In September alone, there were **87 baptisms in just three of the maximum-security prisons**. With the development of Ocean Bridge and God's continued blessings, we expect this effort to be shared with many thousands of those who hunger for the Hope they are desperately searching for.

"Marketplace Ministry"

John and Inez Carney, who live in Pueblo West, Colorado, continue to find creative ways to share the Gospel. Several years ago they passed out "kindness kits" (which included water, food and toiletry items, a WBS Intro lesson and a note stating "Here's something to get you through the day, and something to get you through eternity.") to the homeless. Next they began mailing WBS Intro courses to everyone in the Pueblo West telephone book.

In 2020, John and Inez began what he calls their "marketplace ministry", patterned after Paul's practice in Acts 17 of going into the marketplace to preach Jesus. It works like this. John and Inez park their car in front of a local grocery store and put a magnetic sign on their car door that reads "Free Bible". They stack WBS Bibles on a tray hooked onto the open window and one of them sits in the car to give away Bibles to those who ask for them.

They also sometimes go to the shopping mall food court and into local Starbucks, where they set up a "Free Bible" tabletop sign. John said that this worked well until one man complained about the sign. Not being discouraged, John printed "Free Bible" on T-shirts that he and Inez wore to become walking billboards for their ministry.

John and Inez have personally given away 488 WBS Bibles. They have had discussions with a large group of Jehovah Witnesses and have had two men request baptism. Their helpers, Chad and Beth Potokar and Steve Holloway, have given away dozens more Bibles in recent years. When expressing his excitement to encourage others, John wrote, *"Anyone can do this work."*

On September 21, 2023, Inez passed away at the age of 94. Please remember John and the Carney family in your prayers. John, thank you for your and Inez's example in service to the Lord.

God is Working in Malawi

In March 2022, I logged onto worldbibleschool.org and was searching for Students in Malawi, Africa on the World Bible School Student Board. From that list I adopted a man named Juap William.

As it turned out, Juap was a Pentecostal preacher and I thought this might become interesting. As we went through the lessons, we began to exchange a few messages and Juap was asking some serious questions. He completed all seven studies of the "Master Series", but had not yet obeyed the Gospel. I did not want to give up on him. So as we continued to exchange messages, I would send him some more information on subjects he would asked about. We stayed in touch until I traveled to Malawi in July, at which time I invited him to attend a seminar I was planning for all WBS Students in Malawi and Mozambique. Juap and his wife both attended the seminar and at the end of the day he told me he thoroughly enjoyed the time and had learned a lot about the Bible.

He invited me to come visit his Pentecostal church and present the same material. We arranged a time when I could come and at the conclusion of the studies, Juap, his wife and 10 other members of that church were baptized into Christ!

Then Juap revealed to me that he also served as a bishop in the Pentecostal church and oversaw 16 other congregations. He wanted me to visit all of them and teach the material I had presented to him. My schedule would only allow me to visit one other location, at which, three more put Christ on in baptism.

Juap was so excited about his newfound faith and his discovery of truth. He said it all made sense now. He then shared his journey of faith with me. Juap was brought up as a Muslim, became interested in Christianity and began studying the Bible. He started attending a Presbyterian church, thinking any church claiming to be Christian would be ok, but never gave up on his search for truth.

In his studies, he learned that he needed to be baptized by immersion for the remission of sins. However, the Presbyterian church only sprinkled and even that was not for remission of sins. So, his quest for scriptural baptism led him to the Pentecostals and that is where I found him. His heart was still open to learning the truth and when he heard it, just like the good soil Jesus talked about in Luke 8, he received it and is bringing forth fruit!

Sadly, I had to leave without visiting all the other Pentecostal congregations Juap was affiliated with, so I printed copies of all the studies I had presented and left them with him. I told him he would have to teach it to them. He met with all 16 churches the next week after my departure and presented the material to them. Later that day, he sent me the following email: "I taught what you taught me from the Bible. All 16 branches have agreed and been converted. All are changing their names to church of Christ and are following the New Testament church. We all agreed to follow the truth, not because we want to please you, but God who sent you to us."

There were 389 souls converted from the error of Pentecostalism to true New Testament Christianity! Juap is continuing to study and teach as he and some of the brethren from the Tambala church of Christ in Blantyre, Malawi visit and encourage these new babes in Christ.

"We all agreed to follow the truth, not because we want to please you, but God who sent you to us." -Juap William

Little did I know on that March evening, about one year ago, when I adopted a WBS Student named Juap William that God would bring about such a great harvest of souls. **So far, including the 80 baptisms that I was a part of on my trip, there have been over 550 precious souls brought to the Lord!** Truly, this was a work of the Lord!

Are there others like Juap on the online Student Board ready for adoption? Only God knows! Will you obey God's call to share the Gospel and let Him perform incredible works through you?

Lynn Camp tells of a time when he used to visit Budapest, behind the Iron Curtain. He met Ivan Martos who had permission to travel to Vienna, Austria, for bank business. On one of Ivan's trips, Hungarian guards entered his train just before the Austrian border and found Ivan's Bible. Angrily shouting, "What is a man in your position doing with a Bible?" the guard threw the Bible out the window of the moving train. Ivan was distraught. He poured out the discouraging story when Lynn met him at the Vienna train station.

About two years later, on another trip to Vienna, they met, and this time Ivan was overjoyed. He had received a postal package in Budapest—it was his Bible. An apologetic note accompanied the Bible:

Our children were playing one day along the railroad tracks and found your Bible. Not knowing what it was, one of them took it to his grandmother who immediately recognized it as a Bible. Word guickly spread through the little village on the border. Some of our older people had possessed Bibles before they were banned and remembered the significance and power of the Word of God. We decided to conceal the discovery while those who so desired would make handwritten copies. That joyful task lasted two years. Please forgive our keeping your Bible so long. But you might like to know that we are now a secret band of about 30 who have baptized each other and seek to follow Jesus in our daily lives.

The Bible is God's inspired correspondence! It contains His Gospel seed that is so effective wherever it is sown. It always produces fruit when it encounters "good soil" hearts. That is why we promote Bibles for Millions. Most people are like the Ethiopian official who was reading Isaiah. The **Sower** who went out to **Sow**

How can I express the impact of Edie Connel on the work of World Bible School? Words such as vast, immeasurable and long-lasting come to mind. Yet, with such words, they don't do full service to her impact. I can begin to comprehend this answer by thinking of Jesus' parable of the sower.

Edie was the kind of sower we read about in the Bible. Her dedication to teaching the Gospel, mentoring fellow workers, helping other Christians share Jesus, and connecting souls ready to respond is described perfectly in Jesus' parable. I declare Edie's earthly life is producing 100 times what was sown. How is this possible? Edie was a sower who went out to sow the seed daily. Her last conversation with me involved her comfort in knowing we had her contacts and computer. She was at peace knowing the sowing would continue.

This sower arose early in the morning and sowed seed late into the night. She invested her retirement years in giving, serving and sowing. Because Edie didn't brag, I wasn't aware of how much time she spent working for WBS until her son, Don, told me he would see her working in the morning and still at her desk at 11 at night.

As her "boss," I always felt I should be learning from her experience, and her opinion carried much weight in my decisions. Edie taught me to be considerate and compassionate for other sowers in the field. Sowers who had difficulty changing farm tools and sowers who just needed conversation and encouragement. Her example of patiently talking on the phone for hours has had a tremendous impact on how the WBS Support department cares for fellow sowers.

Upon sending out the announcement of Edie's passing, WBS and other social media accounts received hundreds of responses from Study Helpers, Follow-up Partners, Students, and nearly anyone you can imagine on the geographic, cultural, and language spectrum who were impacted by this sower.

If Edie were here with us today, she would tell us to find the lonely, disheartened, and ADOPT seeking students who need a loving Christian to share Jesus and be willing to FOLLOW-UP! That is what Edie's WBS life was all about. She found inexpressable joy seeing follow-up completed over the years as she received pictures of thousands of souls obeying the Gospel and enjoying a new Life and Hope in Christ.

This faith and this HOPE can only happen when a sower simply goes out to sow. Be a sower, make more sowers, and treasure the memory of this sower, Edie Connel.
